



***Did you know.....just registering your child for Free School Meals means that the academy gets extra money?***

***Register now to make sure we don't miss out***

The Government is giving money to schools to help children from lower income families do their very best. This funding is called a 'Pupil Premium'

**For every child registered, Wymondham High gets £935 this year**

***Please register to make sure your child and others in their class don't miss out***

### **How does it work?**

1. First, check if you qualify—it is not just if you are unemployed, so please look at the list below.
2. Registering is really quick and easy—visit <https://myfreeschoolmeals.com/> and enter your details. If you have any problems with this, please contact our Student Services team, who will be able to help you.
3. If you want your child to have a free, healthy meal at lunchtime, that is great—they will get the free meal (saving you around £400 a year), and the school gets £935 extra
4. If you don't want your child to have the school meals, they can continue as normal - as long as you qualify, and are registered, the academy still gets £935 extra.

***No one will know you have registered, and it will not affect any other benefits you may be claiming.***

### **Do you qualify?**

You can register your child for Free School Meals if you get any of these benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not receiving Working Tax Credit, and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) below £16,190
