



WYMONDHAM HIGH SIXTH FORM DRESS CODE

BOYS

- Dark business suits – brown, grey, navy, black or dark pin striped. Trousers must be full length and not tight fitting.
- Shirts and ties (done up to the collar and tucked in). No T-shirts.
- Smart 'leather look' black or brown shoes. No trainers or boots. No canvas shoes.
- Jumpers may be worn under jackets, but must be of a plain, thin-knitted material and not bulky or patterned.

GIRLS

- Dark trouser or skirt suits (or matching jackets and skirts/trousers) – plain brown, grey, navy, black or dark pin striped (a small, subtle check is acceptable). Skirts must be of an appropriate length (no shorter than knee length) and should not be too stretchy, no maxi skirts, miniskirts or skirts with slits up the side and must not be tight fitting.
- Trousers must be full length and not tight fitting. They should not be three-quarter length.
- No culottes or shorts.
- Jumpers may be worn over blouses and under jackets when it is cold, but they are not a substitute for a jacket. Jumpers must be of a plain, thin-knitted material and not bulky or patterned.
- Smart 'leather look' black, brown or navy shoes. No trainers. No canvas shoes. Very high heels and backless shoes are not appropriate for school.
- Tailored shift dresses (navy, black, grey or patterned within this colour palette)
- Tops without collars (with or without sleeves but not strappy/strapless).
- Black, brown or navy ankle boots.
- Polo neck jumpers.

HAIR, MAKE-UP AND JEWELLERY

- Discreet make-up and jewellery.
- Piercings – only one piercing in each earlobe – no other visible piercing.
- No visible body artistry.
- Hair colour should be a natural shade. No extremes of colour or shaved patterns. Hair should not be shaved on less than a number 2 setting.
- Facial hair should be kept short and neat.

Students may not wear denim, combat trousers, cords or leather. Hoodies are also unacceptable.
