

# DESTINATIONS BRIEF 2020

**Context:** the 2020 destinations cohort below includes a total of 128 applicants (123 Year 13 cohort, and 5 reapplicants from the previous year). Figures in brackets indicate *last year's* cohort (2019 leavers) for comparison.

## UNIVERSITY: 70%

90 out of 128 students have places secured for university 2020/21.

## OTHER ROUTES: 30%

38 out of 128 are at destinations other than university

How many from the total cohort of 128 applied through UCAS in 2020?

75% (80%)

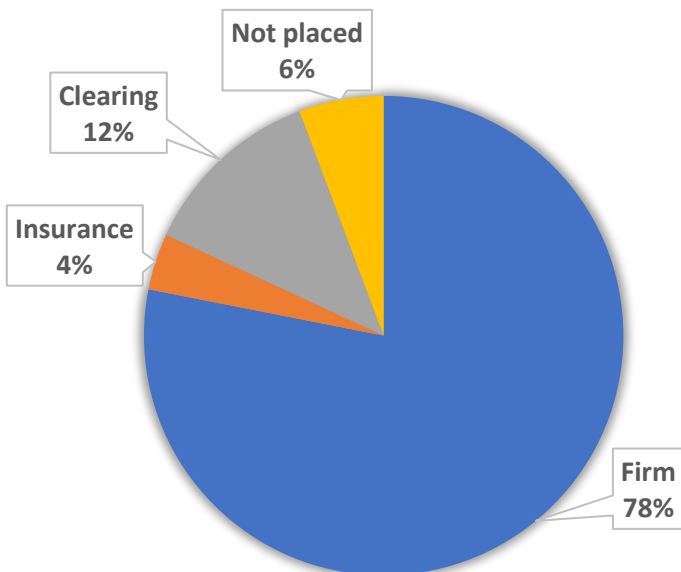
How many of those applicants actually secured places following results?

94% (89%)

The destinations of 'Other Routes' students are likely to take longer to settle this year with the greater uncertainty around Covid-19. We are actively pursuing those students whose destinations are either unknown or undecided. Early figures suggest that, out of 38 students at our most recent point of contact...

- 2 are in Year 14 at WHA
- 5 are applying to university (expected to rise)
- 7 seeking apprenticeships
- 1 armed forces
- 1 straight into full-time work
- 15 currently unconfirmed

## INSTITUTION CHARACTERISTICS:

- 64% went to **top-third universities** as measured by avg. UCAS entry tariff (39%)
- 32% to **Russell Group** institutions (27%)
- 2 students to **medical school** (1)
- 0 students went to Oxbridge (1 place gained – as an 'Insurance'!)
- **1 student went to a Conservatoire**
- 26% of offers were unconditional (27%)

## YEAR 12 LEAVERS

- 5 in total (4)
- 5 voluntary (3)
- Retention Rate from Year 12 to 13-98%

### Where are they now?

- 4 at other FE Colleges (3)
- 1 home-schooled
